

1. Prepare a song selection from any Broadway Musical. Be prepared to sing the full song. The song does not have to be memorized and you may use sheet music.
2. Provide a headshot or recent picture
3. Bring a resume or bio telling us about your acting, singing, and dance abilities
4. Complete audition form

SUBMIT A VIDEO AUDITION: For those who can not attend the auditions you may submit an audition video.

1. Download, print, and fill out audition form from website.
2. Make recording singing a full song from a Broadway musical (computer cam, phone, or camera).
3. Attach video, audition form, resume, and picture and send to beautyandbeastcasting@gmail.com
