### The action takes place in a small kingdom in medieval times.

#### 9 Lead Characters & Large Ensemble

**Princess Winnifred** – F – She hails from a swamp and is a little childish. She's a powerhouse and able to do anything she puts her mind to. She's strong in personality and brimming with energy.

**Queen Aggravain** - F - She is the main antagonist in the play who is holding the kingdom hostage until she finds the perfect princess for her son, Prince Dauntless. She's unapologetically bold, brash, and loud in personality and creates unfair tests for each suitor who comes for her son.

**Prince Dauntless** - M - He's a bit of a dunce. He's not the brightest, but he is the heir apparent to the kingdom. He's friendly and personable and waiting for his perfect princess.

**King Sextimus** – M – He's completely mute. He doesn't speak at all and operates almost exclusively with pantomime. He definitely is a bit mischievous though as he's often spotted chasing skirts around the kingdom.

**The Minstrel** – Any – The Minstrel is the narrator of the story and welcomes the audience into the kingdom. The Minstrel is clever and kind and friendly.

**The Jester** – Any – The Jester often interprets for the king who cannot speak and is often the funniest character in the show. At least, the jester would hope so.

**Sir Harry** – Any – The noble knight of the kingdom who is in love with Lady Larken nearly as much as himself. He's the one who finds Princess Winnifred and he's a man of action.

Lady Larken – Any – The kind and noble first lady to the Queen, Lady Larken is pregnant and wishes to be married before she shows. She's friendly to all she meets.

**The Wizard** – Any – Generally a quiet character, but The Wizard is the essential henchman for Queen Aggravain. With her unfair tests of the princesses, The Wizard is the one to put them into motion.

**Ensemble** – Any – With this being a kingdom, we will need a wide cast for the ensemble to help with the dance numbers.
