Members of the Cornley Drama Society present a classic 1920s whodunit murder mystery set in Haversham Manor and everything is **NOT** ready for opening night.

Everyone plays a dual role as a member of the company and the part and/or parts they play in the play.

This is a very physical show. Actors will be carefully choreographed and must follow direction to the last detail to ensure safety. Though most of the play seems ad-libbed, it must only appear that way. Lines and blocking must be PRECISE. Actors with character roles must be able to fall and get up with little trouble. All adult roles. Open to 17 and older.

Chris (young & ambitious) The Cornley Drama Society Company theatre director who plays Inspector Carter; must be able to play physical comedy & farce, authoritative & determined; English accent; well-spoken

Jonathan (youngish) Company actor who plays Charles Haversham; must be able to play physical comedy & farce and a dead body; English accent; awkward, bad actor

Robert (non-specific age) Company actor who plays Thomas Colleymoore; must be able to play physical comedy, farce & slapstick; English accent; very determined bad actor

Dennis (could be older) **Company actor who plays Perkins**; must be able to play physical comedy & farce; English accent; nervous & forgetful

Max (could be older) Company actor who plays Cecil Haversham and Arthur the Gardner; must be able to play physical comedy & farce; has an awkward kiss with Sandra; English accent; awkward, bad acting

Sandra (middle-aged) Company actress who plays Florance Colleymoore; must be able to play physical comedy & farce; spends large part of play half-dressed and has an awkward kiss with Max; English accent; flirtatious & over-the-top bad acting; must fight

Annie (youngish) Company stage manager; must be able to play farce & very broad physical comedy; NO English accent; must fight

Trevor Company lighting and sound technician; must be able to play physical comedy & farce; English accent; bumbling & awkward

Stage Crew (5-10 all ages) Company stage crew; on-stage members of the The Cornley Drama Society company stage crew working on & repairing the Haversham Manor set and backstage as the stage crew.

Winston (dog, any breed) **Company dog who plays Winston**; a Portuguese Retriever whose owners live in Haversham Manor
