ROLES FOR 10 ADULTS

Chris Gorman (F-presents 32-28) Ken's elegant and attractive wife. A bit high strung.

Ken Gorman (M-presents 32-40) A well-spoken and handsome attorney. A bit high strung.

Claire Ganz (F-presents 30-40) Lenny's gossip-monger, attractive wife. A Westchester, New York housewife type.

Lenny Ganz (M-presents 32-42) An accountant who just wrecked his brand new BMW. Easily irritated, sarcastic, and very likeable.

Ernie Cusack (M-presents 40-55) A smug psychiatrist.

Cookie Cusack (F-presents 40-55) Ernie's wife and a cooking show host with a bad back. She has a very dramatic, physical personality.

Glenn Cooper (M-presents 32-50) An ambitious, polished man prepared for state senate. A Kennedy-type.

Cassie Cooper (F-presents 25-35) A jealous type who believes in the healing power of crystals. Glenn's trophy wife. Insecure, sexy, and shrewish.

Officer Welch (M or F-presents 35-50) A vigorous, straight-talking, veteran police officer.

Officer Pudney (M or F-presents 23-31) A rookie cop.

Four couples arrive at a townhouse of a deputy New York City mayor and his wife to attend a party celebrating their tenth wedding anniversary. However, the four couples soon discover that there are no servants, the hostess is missing, and the deputy mayor has shot himself in the head. (It's only a flesh wound) Comical complications arise when, given everyone's upper-class status, they decide they need to do everything possible to conceal the evening's events from the local police and the media. Even though they don't even know what has transpired! Thus... rumors arise.

The director is looking for actors willing to take a chance with their character's choices. The show should seem spontaneous and chaotic, but it must only appear that way. Actors will need to work hard to memorize lines, follow direction and work as a team with their fellow dinner guests.
